Summary of Event:


Dr. Nilesh Patel delivered an insightful session on GPAT preparation, outlining a strategic approach to excel in competitive exams. He provided a clear understanding of the GPAT (Graduate Pharmacy Aptitude Test) and emphasized the importance of disciplined time management. He recommended the 50-30-20 study strategy, advocating that 50% of preparation time be dedicated to solving previous year and frequently asked questions, 30% to studying standard textbooks, and 20% to tackling unpredictable or novel questions. He further encouraged the formation of study groups with like-minded peers for collaborative learning and problem-solving. Additionally, he shared effective techniques for approaching the exam paper and highlighted key topics across all subjects to streamline preparation.

Dr. Umang Shah delivered a comprehensive overview of the GPAT, beginning with defails, about its administration by the National-Board of Examination in Medical Sciences and the eligibility criteria for applicants. He elaborated on the exam pattern, syllabus, and subject-wise weightage to help students understand the structure of the test. He provided targeted strategies to maximize scores, highlighted important topics and previous year questions for each subject, and recommended standard reference books for effective preparation. He also inspired attendees by sharing success stories and proven strategies adopted by past students from their institution who successfully cleared the GPAT.

Mr. Yash Gadani provided valuable guidance on career pathways following a B.Pharm degree, highlighting various competitive exams and the strategic approaches required to succeed in them. He introduced key postgraduate entrance exams, such as GPAT and PGCET, and discussed renowned institutions like NIPER and other prestigious colleges for pursuing a master's degree in pharmacy. He elaborated on the difficulty levels of these exams and shared effective preparation strategies. Additionally, he introduced Apomind and its specialized batches tailored for GPAT and other pharmacy entrance exams, aimed at supporting students through structured and focused preparation.
